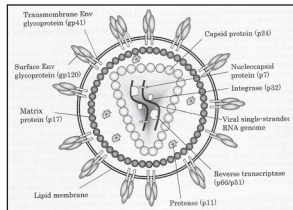

Schematic representation of a mature HIV virion showing the localization of viral proteins.

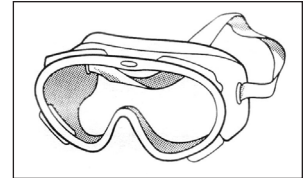
